Why Valve collects and processes data Valve collects and processes personal data for the following reasons: a) if necessary to fulfill our contract with you to provide full gaming services and provide related content and services; b) if necessary to comply with the legal obligations to which we apply (e.g. our obligations to store certain information under tax laws); c) where necessary for the purposes of the legitimate and legal interests of Valve or a third party (e.g. the interests of our other customers), except where such interests are exceeded by your overthrown legitimate interests and rights; or d) if you have agreed to do so. These reasons for collecting and processing personal data determine and limit what personal data we collect and how we use it (section 3 below), how long we store it (section 4 below), who has access to it (section 5 below) and what rights and other control mechanisms are available to you as a user (section 6 below). 3. The types and sources of data we collect 3.1 Basic account data When you set up your account, Valve will collect your email address and country of residence. You must also select a user name and password. Providing this information is necessary to register a Steam user account. When you set up your account, your account is automatically assigned a number (Steam ID) that will later be used to link to your user account without directly ingly ingly ingly personally identifiable information about you. We do not want you to provide or use your real name to set up a Steam user account. 3.2 Transaction and payment details In order to make a transaction on Steam (e.g. to purchase subscriptions to content and services or to finance your steam wallet), you may need to provide payment details to valve to enable the transaction. If you pay with a credit card, you must provide typical credit card information (name, address, credit card number, expiry date and security code) per valve, Valve will process and transmit to the payment service provider of your choice to make the transaction and carry out anti-fraud checks. Likewise, we will track your process through our website and application to verify that you are not a bot and optimize our services. 3.5 Your use of games and other Subscriptions In order to provide you with the Services, we must collect, store and use various information about your activity in our content and services. Based on game statistics, we mean information about your game preferences, game progress, play time, and the device you're using, including the operating system you're using, device settings, unique device identifiers, and crash data. 3.6 Tracking data and cookies We use Cookies, which are text files placed on your computer, and similar technologies (e.g. web beacons, pixels, ad tags and device identifiers) to help us analyze how users use our services, as well as to improve the services we offer to improve the marketing, analysis or functionality of the website. The use of cookies is standard on the Internet. Although most web browsers automatically accept cookies, the decision whether or not to accept cookies is yours. Anyone can access this information by asking for your Steam ID. The availability of any additional information about you can be controlled via the Steam Community user profile page; data publicly available on your profile page is automatically accessible through the Steamworks API. The types and sources of data we collect 3.1 Basic account data When you set up your account, Valve will collect your email address and country of residence. You must also select a user name and password. Providing this information is necessary to register a Steam user account.
